Welcome to Tall Timber Ranch!

We welcome guests year round for a two-night minimum stay (three nights on holiday weekends). Unless you plan to reserve the whole camp, additional guests may be on site; please plan on seeing others around and sharing meals with them.

It's also important to note there is no cell service on our campus and internet is generally not available to guests, except in emergencies.

LODGING

Lodging is available by building (not by bed). This nightly rate includes firewood for your use.

Tall Timber has so much to offer, it just depends on the season and your interests! The following items require an additional fee, in order to offset related staff and facility expenses.

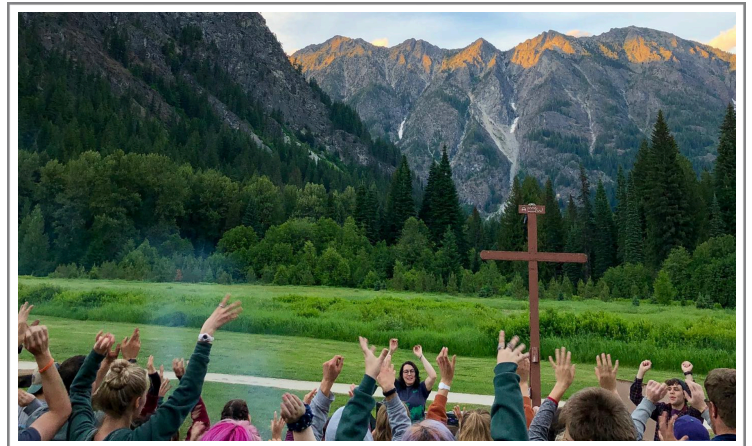
Rent Gear: Cross Country Skis and Boots, Snowshoes, Sleeping Bags, Individual Tents

Amenities to Enjoy

Depending on the season, there are a variety of great activities available for everyone who visits Tall Timber.

On-Site: Labyrinth, Horseshoes, Playground, Volleyball Court, Basketball Court, Cross-Country Skiing and Snowshoeing, Beach Access to White River, Interpretive Trail

Lodge: Sit by fire, Utilize Bathrooms/Showers, Play Board Games/Puzzles, Foosball, Ping-Pong, Carpet Ball, and Pool, Enjoy Outdoor Picnic Tables

Nearby Hikes: Twin Lakes, Dirty Face, White River Road, Napeequa Falls

Nearby Activities: Lake Wenatchee State Park, Leavenworth, downhill skiing at Steven's Pass

Please note:

- Bring your own bath towel, pillow, and sleeping bag (or sheets/blankets).
- Participants (age 5+) must purchase meals, unless staying in the campground; here, it is expected that you will use wildlife-resistant food storage.
- We strive to accommodate dietary restrictions communicated in advance of your stay! That said, note that our kitchen is not certified gluten-free.
- We are a peanut-free facility and ask that you not bring any products containing peanuts with you. In general, we do not utilize other nuts, but please check with us if you have a known allergy.
- Nestled in a wilderness area, we do not facilitate the use of motorized vehicles.

Please note:

- Each building has a wood-burning stove, except Ephrata, Snohomish, and Quincy (electric heat only).
- The entire camp can be reserved for a nightly lodging rate of \$5,000. Meeting areas are provided free of charge.
